Maintain in perfect working condition the equipment and auxiliary materials and perform the relevant administrative steps.

1. Performing safe operational immersions and operating/maintaining simple hyperbaric equipment and facilities.
2. Performing elementary underwater works of cutting and welding, using conventional basic methods.
3. Performing basic underwater works in hydraulic works and use of explosives.
4. Performing underwater works of atsea repairing and refloating.
5. Performing the administration, management and marketing of a small company or workshop.
