### DESCRIPTION OF THE PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

#### General skills

To produce jewellery by operating and maintaining workshop facilities and equipment, achieving low production costs with the required quality, in a safe and healthy working environment. To organise, administer and manage a small jewellery workshop.

#### Skill units

1. Prepare wax models for microfusion.
2. Obtain pieces of jewellery from precious metals by casting.
3. Produce pieces of jewellery or items of jewellery.
4. Produce jewellery by applying fire in its production.
5. Set precious stones.
6. Carry out administrative, management and marketing tasks.

### RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

Jewellers, silversmiths, goldsmiths, setters, casters skilled in microfusion, jewellery modelers, sculptors working with precious metals.
