1. Organizing and controlling the reception, storage and dispatch of raw materials, auxiliary materials and finished products in the beverages-production industry.
2. Performing the operations of winemaking and making of other fermented beverages.
3. Conducting the process of distillation and making spirit, liquors and other beverages.
4. Organizing and controlling the operations of packing and packaging of food products.
5. Applying hygiene and safety rules and controlling compliance thereof in the food-processing industry.
