3. Scheduling and controlling the operations of restoration, maintenance, defence and organization of forestry resources.
4. Scheduling and controlling the works for the construction and maintenance of parks and gardens, revegetation of the natural environment and landscape restoration.
5. Organizing and controlling the maintenance, repair, and operation of the facilities, machinery and equipment of a business farm.
6. Scheduling and controlling the activities of public use and conservation of the natural environment.
7. Scheduling and organizing the processes of reproduction, spreading and production of plants in nurseries.
