General competence

Manage and perform the administration of a ship. Control and conduct a ship's navigation and course under any conditions.

Organize and perform the activities of extraction, processing and preservation of fish; organize and perform the activities of maritime transport, in all cases ensuring safety and observing the applicable national and international regulations.

Competence units

1. Obtain the required ship's clearance documents before leaving or arriving at a port.
2. Performing the operations of stability, trimming, and manoeuvring of the ship.
3. Controlling the ship's navigation and course under any conditions.
4. Organizing and performing the activities of extraction and preservation of the product.
5. Organizing and controlling on-board safety, survival and health care.
