PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

General competence

Perform the activities of feeding, handling, hygiene and health of the animals grown for obtaining livestock products, pets, or animals used for experimental purposes, thereby achieving the quality required by the market under conditions of safety and health and protecting and preserving the production environment. Operate and maintain in operating condition the facilities, machinery and equipment required. Organizing and managing a livestock farm.

Competence units

1. Organizing and managing a family farm.
2. Preparing, handling and maintaining in operating condition the farm's facilities, machinery and equipment .
3. Perform the operations of production of milk, meat- and wool-yielding livestock and poultry farming for egg production.
4. Perform the operations of rational management of livestock.
5. Perform the operations of production and care of laboratory, experimentation and other small animals in animal houses and rearing pens.
6. Perform clinical, care and handling operations for pets.
7. Perform the operations of shoeing, taming and basic care for horses and other animals.
