PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

General competence

Perform the works that are characteristic of forestry as well as those of surveillance, maintenance and protection of the natural environment, under appropriate conditions of safety and hygiene and preserving the production environment. Operating and maintaining in operating condition the machinery and equipment required. Organize and manage a family forestry undertaking.

Competence units

1. Organizing and managing a family farm.
2. Preparing, handling and maintaining in operating condition the farm's facilities, machinery and equipment.
3. Performing the processes and works required to harvest forest produce on a basis of rational exploitation.
4. Perform the tasks/operations of cultivation of reproduction, spreading and production of plants in nurseries.
5. Perform the processes and works required to plant trees and scrub on woodland scrubland, as well as those of maintenance, conservation, inventory and defence of wooded land.
6. Perform the tasks of control and surveillance of the natural environment, as well as the activities involving the use of natural areas by the public.

RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

Chainsaw operator / clearer. Forestry machinery operator. Forester. Reafforester. Nurseryman. Forest warden. Environment warden. Nature guide. Fire guard. Assistant in hunting areas and fish farms. Assistant in interpretation centres.
