3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out the warehouse auxiliary operations, reception of goods, deconsolidation, location, picking and delivery of orders, loads and unloads, in coordination or in a teamwork, under the supervision of a responsible, following the received instructions and applying the proper procedures and equipment, in terms of productivity and following safety, health and risk prevention regulation. This general competence is specified in the following **competency units** (UC):

- Carry out auxiliary operations of reception, placement, maintenance and load expedition in the warehouse in an integrated way within the team (UC1325_1).
- Prepare orders efficiently and effectively, following established procedures (UC1326_1).
- Handle of bulks with forklifts (UC0432_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Auxiliary storage operations (MF1325_1).
- Orders preparation (MF1326_1).
- Handling of loads with forklifts (MF0432_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in warehouse auxiliary activities (MP0287)

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Carry out operations and auxiliary activities related to storage of goods, from documentation and established working procedures.
- Deliver different types of orders, from different workflows using appropriate equipment and techniques following safety and hygienic postural conditions.
- Operate forklifts and drive loads in different scenarios of movements inside a warehouse.
- Carry out maintenance operations in handling equipment and forklifts in a warehouse.
- Act applying recommendations and standards of safety and occupational risks prevention in the auxiliary warehouse operations and handling of goods and products.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate work in warehouses of companies and organizations of all kinds, public and private, under the direct supervision of a responsible. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Porters working in loading and unloading, storage and / or markets.
- Warehouse porters.
- Drivers-operators of forklifts, in general.
- Pallet truck drivers.
- Packers, baggers and taggers of loads.
- Order picker.
- Load and unload workers in general.
- Logistics operator worker.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1522/2011, of October 31st, by which five professional certificates of the professional family "Trade and Marketing" that are included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established, and the professional certificate established as Appendix I of the Royal Decree 1377/2008, of August 1st. (Annex I, Code: COML0110).

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
