# Professional Certificate Level 1 in MAPN0109 AUXILIARY AND SUPPORT ACTIVITIES TO VESSELS IN PORTS (This translation has no legal status)

#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to perform the watch keeping functions of fishing vessels, as well as maintenance and lubrication of on board elements, during the ship's stay in the port, carrying out, under the direction of a superior, the works of loading, unloading and bracing of fishing gears and provisions, and the maintenance and repair of fishing equipments out of use, participating in different manoeuvres performed by the ship in the port, following safety standards every time. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Collaborate in the loading, unloading and transfer of ships in the port (UC1296\_1).
- Carry out the works of bracing, maintenance, handling and repair of fishing elements during the ship's stay in the port (UC1297\_1).
- Collaborate in the maintenance and bracing of a fishing vessel (UC1298\_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Manoeuvre of ships in ports (MF1296 1).
- Maintenance and repair of fishing elements in ports (MF1297\_1).
- Maintenance and conservation of the fishing vessel (MF1298\_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in auxiliary and support activities to vessels in ports (MP0163).

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Loading and unloading of fishing gears compiling with the procedures and techniques that ensure their safety and effective use of them.
- Participate in the manoeuvre of transfer of the ship', compiling the procedures and seafarer techniques that ensure the safety and operability of it.
- Carry out the cleaning-up, pierced and frayed operations, installation and assembly of small breakdowns that may occur in the fishing gears.
- Apply the techniques and procedures used for the maintenance and conservation of the hull, deck equipment and security facilities.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate may work in the maritime and fisheries sector and specifically in the economic activities of: commercial fishing, fishing net factories, and other auxiliary fishing industries. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Boat keeper in the docks
- Storeroom keeper.
- Assistant to the net maker.

#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

#### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

#### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9

- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### Legal basis

Royal Decree 718/2011, of May 20th, by which six professional certificates of the Professional Family of Maritime and Fishing Industries that include in the National Repertoire of professional certificates (Appendix I, Code: MAPN0109).



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#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

#### **Entry/access requirements:**

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
