2. TRANSLATED TITLE OF THE CERTIFICATE (EN)

Professional Certificate Level 1 in MAPN0310 MOORING IN PORTS AND BUOYS (This translation has no legal status)

3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out the mooring, docking and undocking, of vessels in ports and floating buoys, as well as connection and disconnection of hopes of buoys, respecting the safety and security requirements and following the applicable regulations in these operations. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Go through the steps of mooring and unmooring of vessels in ports (UC1308_1).
- Perform mooring operations, connection / disconnection of hopes, and unmooring of vessels to buoys (UC1309_1).
- Participate in maritime emergencies and implement safety standards at work (UC0733_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Mooring and unmooring of ships in ports (MF1308_1).
- Mooring, connection / disconnection of hopes, and unmooring of vessels to buoys (MF1309_1).
- Safety and first aid on board (MF0733_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in Mooring in ports and buoys (MP0319).

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Secure and let out the ropes in the mooring and unmooring maneuvers of vessels.
- Develop the process of mooring / unmooring and connection / disconnection of cables and chain applying
 occupational risks prevention measures and pollution prevention measures.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.





4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate may work in the maritime and fisheries sector, and specifically in the activities of a Port ship mooring operations companies. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Berthing master.
- Buoys berthing master.
- Seafarer.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1533/2011 of October 31st, by which seven professional certificates of the Professional Family of Maritime and Fishing Industries, included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates (Appendix III, Code: MAPN0310).

Amended by Royal Decree 622/2013, of August 2nd, by which a professional certificate of the Professional Family of Maritime and Fishing Industries, included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates is established, and the professional certificates established as Appendix I, II and III of Royal Decree 1533/2011, of October 31st, and as Appendix I, III and IV of Royal Decree 1774/2011, of December 2nd are updated.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
