3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to do basic auxiliary operations related to external reception, storage and domestic supply of chemical products, as well as those concerning simple laboratory tasks and routine operations of chemical process following instructions and, when appropriate, under supervision, complying with established procedures and occupational personal risk prevention and environmental protection measures established by the company. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Do the cleaning and disinfecting of materials, equipment and facilities where chemical products are being use (UC1310_1).
- Do storage operations of chemical and by-products (UC1311 1).
- Do basic auxiliary laboratory operations in chemical laboratories and in the processes of the chemical industry and related (UC1312_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Cleaning and disinfection of materials, equipment and facilities in chemical laboratories and industry (UC1310_1).
- Warehouse operations of chemical and by-products products (UC1311 1).
- Auxiliary basic operations in chemical laboratories and in chemical industry processes and related (UC1312 1).
- Practical training at the workplace in auxiliary and warehouse operations in chemical industries and laboratories (MP0144).

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Give support to the reception and sorting of raw materials and chemicals for their later use.
- Do simple cleaning and disinfection of materials, equipment and facilities tasks, avoiding unnecessary stops during the process and under instructions of a superior.
- Do auxiliary basic laboratory and chemical industry operations, under the supervision of superior responsibility.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate may work in chemical companies, laboratory areas, production plants, auxiliary plants and warehouses of the chemical industry sector. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Drug storage assistant.
- Development laboratory assistant.
- Production line assistant.
- Assistant in processes in the chemical industry.
- Storage assistant of pharmaceuticals and by-products.
- Research and experimentation laboratory assistant
- Assistant in cleaning and disinfecting facilities, devices and laboratory equipment.
- Assistant in chemical plants, energy and auxiliary services.
- Chemical storage assistant.
- Sewage plants assistant.
- Water treatment plant assistant.

The holder of this professional certificate has recognition of the basic level training in labour risk prevention, according to Annex IV of the Royal Decree 39/1997 of 17 of January approving the Labour Risks Prevention Act.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9

- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9

- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 719/2011, of May 20th, by which ten professional certificates of the professional family Chemicals, included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates, and a professional certificate established as Appendix III in the Royal Decree 1970/2008, of November 28th is updated. (Appendix I, Code: QUIE0308)



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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
