#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to perform the surfaces and furniture cleaning and maintenance in buildings and shops selecting the techniques, tools, products and machines to ensure the hygiene, care and maintenance, when appropriate, under the supervision of a competent professional, in compliance with applicable regulations in safety and health. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Perform the cleaning of floors, walls and ceilings in buildings and shops (UC0972\_1).
- Carry out the cleaning of furniture located inside spaces (UC0996\_1).
- Perform the cleaning of windows in buildings and shops (UC1087\_1).
- Perform the cleaning and treatment of surfaces in buildings and shops using machinery (UC1088\_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Cleaning of floors, walls and ceilings in buildings and shops (MF0972\_1).
- Cleaning of furniture located inside spaces (MF0996 1).
- Cleaning of windows in buildings and shops (MF1087\_1).
- Techniques and procedures of cleaning and treatment of surfaces in buildings and shops using machinery (MF1088 1).
- Practical training at the workplace in surfaces and furniture cleaning in buildings and shops (MP0102).

As a reference, the learning outcomes included in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Perform the cleaning, treatment and maintenance of floors, walls and ceilings in buildings and shops defined in the work plans.
- Perform the cleaning operations of the interior furniture as defined in the work plans.
- Perform operations on window cleaning in buildings and shops as defined in the work plans.
- Perform cleaning operations using machinery according to the technical instructions.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.







#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of the certificate exercises his/her activity in the public and private sectors, in different centers and facilities and their respective equipment developing cleaning functions.

The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Cleaners in general.
- Laborer specialized in cleaning.
- Cleaning specialist.
- Glass cleaner.
- Expert in building cleaning.
- Building glazier.
- Window cleaner.

#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### **Legal basis**

Royal Decree 1378/2009, of August 28th, by which a professional certificate of the professional family "Sociocultural and community services", included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates (Appendix I, Code: SSCM0108) is established. .







#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

### **Entry/access requirements:**

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
