Professional Certificate Level 2 in ARTB0211 JEWELLERY REPAIR (This translation has no legal status)

3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to receive, analyse and repair pieces of jewellery, replacing gems, guaranteeing the quality and security of operations and organising the professional activity of a craft workshop. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Receive and analyse pieces of jewellery (UC2045_2).
- Repair jewellery parts (UC2046_2).
- Replace gems (UC2047_2).
- Organise the professional activity of a craft workshop (UC1690_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Reception and analysis of jewellery pieces (MF2045_2).
- Repair of jewellery parts (MF2046 2).
- Setting gems (MF2047 2).
- Organisation of the professional activity of a craft workshop (MF1690 2).
- Practical training at the workplace in jewellery repair (MP0440)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the reception at the counter of jewellery pieces, noting the client's requirements, filling in the reception envelope and estimating the budget.
- Participate in carrying out an analysis of viability and proposal for repair in a workshop of a piece of jewellery, taking into account the level of deterioration, the type of piece, the gems involved, its finish and originality.
- Participate in the preparation, adaptation, modification, adjustment, assembly and combination of the elements used in the repair of jewellery pieces based on simple operations that comply with the regulations on occupational risk prevention (PPE) and environmental protection.
- Take part in the application of techniques for setting precious stones in pieces of jewellery, selecting the gems, preparing surfaces for the setting and using machines, tools, implements and optical equipment, while complying with the law governing occupational risk and environmental protection.
- Carry out the polishing, manual shining, electroplating, cleaning and drying of the jewellery pieces being repaired (production, adaptation, modification or replacement), ensuring their quality and viability and complying with the regulations on occupational risk and environmental protection.



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4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the craft sector in the following activities: Traditional jewellery; Jewellery and goldsmith industry and workshops; Watch and jewellery repair; Manufacture of jewellery and similar articles; Retail trade in watches and jewellery in specialised establishments.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Jeweller in general.
- Artistic and art jeweller.
- Goldsmith.
- Craft metal founder.
- Watchmaker's and jeweller's assistant.
- Jewellery salesperson.
- Jewellery repairer.
- Setter.
- Gem expert.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree Royal Decree 613/2013 of 2 August, establishing three professional certificates in the professional family Arts and Crafts, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates, and updating the professional certificates established as Appendices II and V of Royal Decree 1521/2011 of 31 October. 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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
