3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to assemble and start up equipment goods and industrial machinery using assembly plans and technical instructions and the required tools, and to maintain the equipment goods and industrial machinery in operating conditions and available during the guarantee period, while complying with the standards governing occupational risk prevention and environmental protection. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Assemble, repair and start up mechanical systems (UC1263_2).
- Assemble, repair and start up pneumatic, hydraulic, electrical and electronic systems for equipment goods and industrial machinery (UC1264_2).
- Carry out machining and join operations in the assembly of equipment goods and industrial machinery (UC1265_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Techniques of assembly, repair and start-up of mechanical systems (MF1263_2).
- Techniques of assembly, repair and start-up of electrical, electronic, pneumatic and hydraulic systems (MF1264_2).
- Techniques of Metal working (MF12615_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in the assembly and start-up of equipment goods and industrial machinery (MP0097)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Assemble and start up mechanical systems.
- Assemble and start up electrical and electronic systems.
- Assemble and start up pneumatic and hydraulic systems.
- Carry out manufacturing procedures (feeding, discharge, automated or manual processes).
- Assemble and check the final product through integration of the different technologies used.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the assembly and installation of machinery and industrial equipment. The holder may carry out activity in the Technical Assistance Services of companies manufacturing equipment goods and machine tools. The holder may work in the industrial sector, in the equipment goods manufacturing, industrial machinery and similar subsectors.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Repair mechanic for industrial machinery in general.
- Installer and adjuster of industrial machines and equipment in general.
- Installer and adjuster/repairer of automated machinery.
- Industrial maintenance mechanic.
- Assembler-adjuster for industrial machinery in general.
- Electrical and mechanical assembler in general.

<p>Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Level of the certificate</p> <p>The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).</p> <p>The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Grading scale/Pass requirements</p> <p>The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.</p> <p>The grading system is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - FAIL: 0 to 4.9 - PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9 - PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9 - PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10
<p style="text-align: center;">Access to next level of education/training</p> <p>This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.</p> <p>For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Legal basis</p> <p>Royal Decree 1216/2009 of 17 July, establishing four professional certificates in the professional family Metal working, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix II, Code: FMEE0208)</p>

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
