## **3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out installation, start-up and maintenance operations on lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation systems for persons and goods in buildings and plants, in accordance with established installation processes and assembly plans, meeting the required quality standards, and complying with the current laws and regulations and personal and environmental safety conditions. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Install lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment (UC1877\_2).
- Maintain lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment (UC1878\_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Installation of lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment (MF1877\_2).
- Maintenance of lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment (MF1878\_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in installation and maintenance of lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment (MP0315).

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Take part in the start-up of hydraulic and pneumatic systems for lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment, applying assembly techniques for construction in accordance with technical specifications.
- Take part in the assembly of electrical panel boards and electrical systems for lifts and stationary lifting and transportation equipment, based on the technical documentation, applying the Low Voltage Electrotechnical Regulations and acting in accordance with occupational risk prevention regulations.
- Collaborate on the mechanical maintenance of a lift or stationary lifting and transportation equipment, while it is in service, and using the technical documentation.
- Assist in the diagnosis and location of breakdowns in the installation of lifts and/or stationary lifting and transportation equipment.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the installation and maintenance areas of companies dedicated to the manufacture, installation and maintenance of equipment and stationary lifting and transportation systems for people and goods. The holder may work in manufacturing industry in the following productive activities: manufacture of lifting and handling machinery; repair and installation of machinery and equipment; repair and maintenance of other transportation materials. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Lift assembler/fitter.
- Lifting equipment assembler/fitter.
- Lift and similar repair mechanic.
- Fitter of lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment.
- Maintenance technician working on lifts and other stationary lifting and transportation equipment.

The holder of this professional certificate has recognition of the basic level training in labour risk prevention, according to Annex IV of the Royal Decree 39/1997 of 17 of January approving the Labour Risks Prevention Act.

#### **5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE**

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

## Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

#### Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### Legal basis

Royal Decree 1079/2012 of 13 July, establishing four professional certificates in the professional family Installation and Maintenance, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix I, Code: IMAQ0110)



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# 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

## This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

#### Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
