Professional Certificate Level 2 in IMSE0111 LIVE MUSIC AND VISUAL ENTERTAINMENT (This translation has no legal status)

#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to provide musical sessions with the presence of the public in venues or for radio audiences, using live musical and visual entertainment techniques, organising and preparing the resources needed to develop them and defining musical and visual environments, working on the programming and promotion of the sessions in a stable venue or radio station. All this must be adapted to the specifications of the management of the venue or the programming of the broadcaster, while meeting the quality requirements and observing the law on prevention of occupational and environmental risks. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare the infrastructure and collaborate on the programming and promotion of live musical and visual entertainment sessions (UC1396\_2).
- Stage live musical entertainment sessions, including lighting, staging and visual elements (UC1397 2).
- Perform live visual entertainment sessions, including lighting, staging and musical elements (UC1398\_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Programming and promotion of live musical and visual entertainment sessions (MF1396\_2)
- Perform live musical entertainment sessions live, including lighting, staging and visual elements (MF1397\_2).
- Performance of live visual entertainment sessions, integrating lighting, staging and musical elements (MF1398 2).
- Practical training at the workplace in live music and visual entertainment (MP03423)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Prepare plans to promote live musical and visual entertainment sessions, according to the characteristics of the communication media, actions and materials.
- Prepare the technical and artistic documentation on live musical and visual animation sessions, preparing materials, organising resources and using the appropriate information and symbols.
- Connect and adjust the different pieces of equipment used in live musical and visual entertainment sessions, ensuring their correct operation, under strict technical and safety criteria.
- Apply techniques for organising live musical and visual entertainment sessions, operating the sound or image system, meeting established quality standards and respecting the current law.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the image and sound sector, and specifically in the sub-sectors or activities of: spectacles (discotheques, night clubs, dance rooms, concert halls or festivals), events (fashion shows, publicity launches) and radio broadcasters (musical programmes).

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Disc jockey (discotheque)
- Radio disc jockey
- Disc jockey
- Video jockey
- Video disc jockey

#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

#### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

#### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### **Legal basis**

Royal Decree 621/2013 of 2 August, establishing two professional certificates in the professional family Image and sound, which is included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix II, Code: IMSE0111)

#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

#### **Entry/access requirements:**

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
