# Professional Certificate Level 2 in MAPN0111 LOCAL FISHING (This translation has no legal status)

### **3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out operations of fishing vessels on board and engine room, commanding the navigation, as well as the catching and preservation of the capture, within the established geographic limits, respecting safety requirements and complying the law. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units** (UC):

- Arrange vessel clearance and fishing licences management (UC0735\_2).
- Carry out vessel's manoeuvres and loading (UC0736\_2).
- Carry out vessel's navigation operations (UC0737\_2).
- Carry out extractive fishing and captures preservation operations (UC0738\_2).
- Carry out operations in cases of emergencies at sea (UC0739\_2).
- Check the operational parameters of the propulsion engine and the vessel's auxiliary equipment and facilities (UC0740\_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Vessel's and fishing administrative organisation (MF0735\_2).
- Vessel's loading and manoeuvre (MF0736\_2).
- Vessel's course and communications (MF0737\_2).
- Coastal fishing (MF0738\_2).
- Internal safety and health care on board (MF0739\_2).
- Operation and management of the vessel's propulsion engine and auxiliary equipment (MF0740\_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in local fishing (MP0411)
- (See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the manoeuvres and loading of the vessel.
- Analyse the information from nautical reports and from the tools and equipment assisting navigation, and the position of the vessel on the nautical chart to trace its course, avoiding the dangers of the coast and collisions with other vessels.
- Organise and carry out tack and jibe manoeuvres, and check the species captured and their preservation, following the instructions of a superior.
- Participate in the maintenance of the propulsion engine and auxiliary systems.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the maritime/fisheries sector, specifically in the productive activities consisting of: Extractive fishing; Fishing companies; and Aquaculture. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Local fishing vessel skipper.
- Skipper in charge of coastal fishing vessels.
- Skipper in charge of auxiliary vessels dedicated to aquaculture.

The holder of this professional certificate can be recognised by the title of Local fishing vessel skipper according to Royal Decree 36/2014, which regulates the professional titles of fisheries sector, following the established procedure and the authorised centers.

### **5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE**

#### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

### Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

## Legal basis

Royal Decree 1774/2011 of 2 December, establishing four professional certificates in the Professional Family of Maritime and Fishing Industries, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix I, Code: MAPN0111).



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### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

### This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

### Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
