3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out all the operations of the process of packaging pharmaceutical and similar products, controlling the operation, start-up and shutdown of the installations and equipment, under established safety, quality and environmental conditions, being responsible for the first-level maintenance of the equipment, and sampling and carrying out simple tests needed to maintain the process within the planned production conditions. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare equipment and installations and operate auxiliary services for pharmaceutical and similar processes (UC0050_2).
- Package batches of pharmaceutical and similar products (UC0323_2).
- Carry out reconciliation and control in the packaging process of pharmaceutical and similar products (UC0324 2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Installations, services and equipment for the manufacture of pharmaceutical and similar products (MF0050_2).
- Packaging of pharmaceutical and similar products (MF0323 2).
- Controls in the process of packaging pharmaceutical and similar products (MF0324_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in packaging operations for pharmaceutical and similar goods (MP0251)
 (See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).
 As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:
- Use the technical information relating to the packaging of pharmaceutical and similar products correctly.
- Take part in the preparation of the process machines and auxiliary services, and check and record the data relating to their operation.
- Operate the control systems of a packaging unit for pharmaceutical and similar products, under the supervision of the work centre supervisor.
- Collaborate in the operation of the systems of heat generation and exchange.
- Use process fluids in the packaging of pharmaceutical and similar products, under the supervision of the work centre manager.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in pharmaceutical and similar companies, in the area of packaging pharmaceutical and similar products, such as cosmetics, perfumes, diet products, herbal remedies, special foods and household goods. This work is in the following sectors: pharmaceutical, cosmetics, special food, diet food, household goods, herbal remedies, parapharmacy and perfumery. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Dosage and packaging machine operator.
- Packaging operator.
- Stamping machine operator.
- Box packing machine operator.
- Operator of machines for the manufacture of pharmaceutical and cosmetic products.
- Operator of machines for the preparation of pharmaceutical products, in general.

The holder of this professional certificate has recognition of the basic level training in labour risk prevention, according to Annex IV of the Royal Decree 39/1997 of 17 of January approving the Labour Risks Prevention Act.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 719/2011 of 20 May, establishing ten professional certificates in the professional family Chemicals, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates, and updating the professional certificate established as Appendix III of Royal Decree 1970/2008 of 28 November. (Appendix III, Code: QUIM0309)



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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
