3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to drive taxis, cars and vans safely, responsibly and efficiently, following the instructions received or the service schedule, as appropriate, and applying current laws and regulations governing transport of passengers or freight, health, road and environmental safety, while providing effective service and information to users. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units** (UC):

- Prepare and carry out first-level maintenance on urban and long-distance road transport vehicles (UC1461_2).
- Drive taxis, cars or vans, and carry out the operations related to provision of the service (UC1466_2).
- Provide customer service and customer relations activities (UC1467 2).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- First-level maintenance of road transport vehicles (MF1461_2).
- Taxis, cars and vans driving, and provision of the service (MF1466 2).
- Customer service and customer relations (MF1467 2).
- Practical training at the workplace in professional car and van driving (MP0497)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Carry out basic preventive maintenance on the vehicle, following the vehicle's technical manual and the company's written instructions, and respecting the prevention and occupational health measures at all times, as well as the law governing compliance with environmental regulations.
- Drive the vehicle safely, respecting the regulations, signs and current legislation governing traffic and transport.
- Transport passengers following service quality procedures, respecting occupational health and safety and environmental regulations at all times.
- Carry out the loading/unloading and stevedoring plan, following the procedures designed by the transport company, and respecting the occupational health and safety and environmental regulations at all times.
- Deal with and process any complaints or incidents, following the procedure established by the company, and adopting a positive attitude.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.







4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the road transport sector of passengers or freights transport, in the following productive activities: Urban and long-distance road transport of passengers in vehicles with up to nine seats; taxi transport; other types of road passenger transport; road freight transport; and courrier services. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Driver-owner of a car, taxi or van.
- Taxi driver.
- Professional car driver.
- Driver of vans of up to 4.5 T.
- Delivery service worker in vans of up to 3.5 T.
- Salaried taxi driver.
- Professional driver of passenger transport vehicles with up to nine seats.

To drive motor vehicles by road is necessary to have one of the driving licenses under current rules of traffic and transport of motor vehicles and road safety.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 626/2013 of August 2nd, establishing six professional certificates in the professional family Transport and Vehicle Maintenance, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates, and updating the professional certificates established as Appendix V of Royal Decree 723/2011 of May 20th, and as Appendix V of Royal Decree 1539/2011 of October 31st. (Appendix VI, Code: TMVI0112).







6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
