Professional Certificate Level 3 in AFDA0411 PHYSICAL/SPORTS AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES (This translation has no legal status)

3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to prepare, manage, promote and evaluate physical/sports and recreational projects, as well as organising, animating and directing events, recreational competitions and activities that form part of them, aimed at people with problems that produce some level of disability, adapting them to their characteristics and expectations, guaranteeing their physical integrity and satisfaction and environmental protection, within the cost limits planned. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare, manage, promote and evaluate projects of physical/sports and recreational activities (UC1658_3).
- Specify, direct and lead activities, games and sports with and without adaptations, and collaborate in recreational competitions and physical/sports and recreational events for participants with intellectual disabilities (UC1660_3).
- Specify, direct and lead adapted and specific activities, games and sports, and collaborate in recreational competitions and physical/sports and recreational events for participants with physical disabilities (UC1661_3).
- Specify, direct and lead adapted and specific activities, games and sports, and collaborate in recreational competitions and physical/sports and recreational events for participants with visual disabilities (UC1662_3).
- Be a first responder in case of an accident or emergency situation (UC0272_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Physical/sports and recreational activity projects (MF1658_3).
- Events, recreational competitions, activities and games involving physical/sports and recreational activities for participants with intellectual disabilities (MF1660_3).
- Events, recreational competitions, activities and games involving physical/sports and recreational animation for participants with physical disabilities (MF1661_3).
- Events, recreational competitions, activities and games involving physical/sports and recreational animation for participants with visual disabilities (MF1662_3).
- First aid (MF0272_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in physical/sports and recreational activities for people with disabilities (MP0438)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Collaborate in the preparation of physical/sports and recreational activities linked to the centre's general programming.
- Analyse and adapt the physical/sports and recreational activities for participants with intellectual disabilities, reflecting the methodology applicable and the criteria for the selection of activities, games and sports with and without adaptations.
- Collaborate on the direction, promotion and organisation of events, activities and physical/sports and recreational games for people with intellectual disabilities.
- Analyse and adapt the physical/sports and recreational activities for participants with physical disabilities, reflecting the methodology applicable and the criteria for the selection of adapted and specific activities, games and sports.
- Collaborate on the direction, promotion and organisation of events, activities and physical/sports and recreational games for people with physical disabilities.



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3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- Analyse and adapt physical/sports and recreational activities for participants with visual disabilities, reflecting the methodology applicable and the criteria for the selection of adapted and specific activities, games and sports.
- Collaborate on the direction, promotion and organisation of events, activities and physical/sports and recreational games for people with visual disabilities.
- Identify the first aid required in situations of the most frequent injuries or pathologies and collaborate in its application in accordance with established protocols.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the public or private sector in the following areas: Sports; Leisure and free time; and Tourism. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Physical/sports and recreational leader for people with intellectual disabilities.
- Physical/sports and recreational leader for people with physical disabilities.
- Physical/sports and recreational leader for people with visual disabilities.
- Coordinator of physical/sports activities for people with disabilities.
- Monitor of adapted and specific sports.

The related occupations have specific requirements established in the national and regional regulations.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module. The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1076/2012 of 13 July, establishing six professional certificates in the professional family Physical and Sports Activities, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix VI, Code: AFDA0411)



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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
