Professional Certificate Level 3 in AGAJ0208 FLORAL DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT OF FLORIST ACTIVITIES (This translation has no legal status)

3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to program and manage activities of floristry companies, and to design, carry out and assess innovative compositions and special ornamentations with flowers and plants, as well as supervising ornamentation work. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Organise floristry activities (UC1482_3).
- Design floral compositions and ornamentations (UC1483_3).
- Create innovative compositions and special floral ornamentations and supervise the work of floristry workshops (UC1484_3).
- Manage sales and customer service at a florist (UC1485_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Creation of compositions and special floral ornamentations and supervision of the work of the floristry workshop (MF1484_3).
- Design of floral compositions and ornamentations (MF1483_3).
- Organisation of floristry activities (MF1482_3).
- Management of sales and customer service at a florist (MF1485_3).
- Practical training at the workplace in floral design and management of floristry activities (MP0065)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Prepare and create floral and decorative design for spaces, using flowers or plants.
- Supervise the plant maintenance service.
- Organise the reception, preparation and delivery of orders.
- Carry out promotional actions for floristry products.
- Attend commercial interviews.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the wholesale or retail flower or plant sector, in the following productive activities: Florist establishments. Floristry service companies; Garden centres. Florist departments in department stores. Natural and artificial flower or plant distributors. Interior design companies with flower services. Funeral companies with flower services. Companies organising events with floral design services. Companies with a decoration and window dressing department or office. Hotel and catering companies with a floral ornamentation service. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Master in a plastic arts and/or design workshop.
- Florist shop assistant.
- Plant and/or sales section worker.
- Shop supervisor.
- Florist warehouse manager.
- Floristry workshop master.
- Florist craft worker.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1519/2011 of 31 October, establishing seven professional certificates in the professional family Agriculture, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix V, Code: AGAJ0208)



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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
