2. TRANSLATED TITLE OF THE CERTIFICATE (EN)

Professional Certificate Level 3 in MAPN0209 ORGANISATION OF FISH AUCTIONS (This translation has no legal status)

3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** coordinate and supervise the reception, classification and labelling for auction of the fishery products, complying with the current law relating to quality control and occupational safety and health.

This general competence is divided into the following skills units (UC):

- Participate in the organisation and monitoring of the conditions of the premises, facilities, equipment and staff of the fish auction (UC0288_3).
- Monitor the source of the product received for auction, ensuring its traceability, appropriate size and hygienic and health status (UC0289_3).
- Supervise the correct reception, classification, labelling and exhibition of the product in the auction (UC0290 3).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Management of fish auctions (MF0288_3).
- Control of products in fish auctions (MF0289_3).
- Storage and exhibition of products at a fish auction (MF0290 3).
- Practical training at the workplace in organisation of fish auctions (MP0168)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the tasks of organisation and hygiene/health supervision of the facilities and equipment where the fisheries products are deposited and handled.
- Take part in the work of organising and supervising the handling following reception of the products.
- Carry out the work of recognition, distribution and supervision of the products received.
- Take part in the legal and health checks of the products received.
- Use the labels for the fishery products in accordance with the source of the products received.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.



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4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the maritime/fisheries sector, within the sub-sectors of fishing and shellfish gathering, and specifically in productive activity of fish and shellfish trading. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Fish auctions manager.
- Fishery product warehouse manager.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 718/2011 of 20 May, establishing six professional certificates in the professional Maritime/Fishing family, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix VI, Code: MAPN0209)



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6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
