3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to manage and coordinate the activities of the vessel with the competent administrations, both in the port and at sea, with respect to the authorisations, certificates, safety and security, the crew and the fishing and commercial activity with the harvest, while respecting applicable regulations. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Contribute to the operations on the deck of a fishing vessel (UC0010_1).
- Manage the vessel's documents and its fishing activity during the trip and/or tide (UC1896_3).
- Manage the documents linked to the vessel as a structural element and its safety and security in the port (UC1897_3).
- Manage the documents related to fishing as a commercial activity in the port (UC1898_3).
- Act in maritime emergencies and apply occupational safety rules (UC0733_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Work on the deck on the fishing vessel (MF0010_1).
- Management of the vessel's fishing activity (MF1896_3).
- Documents needed for the management of the vessel (MF1897_3).
- Documents needed for fishing activity (MF1898_3).
- Safety and first aid on board (MF0733_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in fishery documents (MP0320)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF). As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce

the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Identify the administrative files related to the Maritime Register and the certification of vessels.
- Collaborate on the presentation of documents to process the administrative files related to professional qualifications and authorisation of vessels.
- Participate in the processes of handling procedures relating to the vessel's fishing activity.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the maritime/fisheries sector, mainly in the sectors of the fishing industry that carry out in: extractive fishing and aquaculture. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Administrative specialist in fishing industry.
- Authorisation clerk for fishing vessels.
- Administrative documentation manager for fishing vessels.



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5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1774/2011 of 2 December, establishing four professional certificates in the professional family Maritime and fishing industry, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix III, Code: MAPN0610)

Amended by Royal Decree 622/2013 of 2 August, establishing two professional certificates in the professional family Maritime and fishing industry, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates and update the professional certificates established in Appendices I, II and III of Royal Decree 1533/2011 of 31 October, and as Appendices I, III and IV of Royal Decree 1774/2011 of 2 December.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
