3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to program, organise, promote and evaluate social intervention actions aimed to develop citizenship participation and the articulation of community organization processes. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Establish and maintain relationships with the main community actors: population, specialists and local authorities, promoting interrelationships among them (UC1020_3).
- Promote citizens' participation in community projects and community resources (UC1021_3).
- Promote the planning, development and assessment of social and citizens' interventions and projects developed between the different actors that shape a community or local area (UC1022_3).
- Participate, support and accompany in the creation and development of the network of grass-roots associations (UC1023_3).
- Define communication and promotion strategies for different community projects and actions (UC1024_3).
- Apply mediation procedures and techniques in the management of conflicts between community agents (UC1025 3).
- Include the gender perspective in social intervention projects (UC1026_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Actors of community processes (MF1020_3).
- Citizenship participation (MF1021 3).
- Methodology of community mobilization (MF1022_3).
- Promotion and support of associations (MF1023 3).
- Techniques and tools for information and promotion of community mobilization (MF1024_3).
- Conflict management between community actors (MF1025 3).
- Promotion of equal opportunities between men and women (MF1026 3).
- Practical training at the workplace in Community mobilization (MP0142)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Collaborate in the configuration of tools and instruments required for information collection.
- Take part in the creation of information and communication channels between the organization and the community of reference.
- Take part in the process of analysing the community reality considering either objective/quantitative or subjective/qualitative methodologies.
- Collaborate in the development of a project considering the different key community partners.
- Assist a process of participative assessment.
- Accompany and support the grass-roots associations in the area.
- Take part in the process of community mediation.
- Carry out the integration of a gender perspective in a community social intervention project developed by the organisation.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.







4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the sector that provides social services to the participants of a community, to organise community activities in public, private or association's initiatives that include community interventions and/or citizenship participation programmes and projects: Social services centres; Community centres; local associations or local services. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Community development worker in general.
- Sociocultural development worker.
- Social development agent.
- Local development agent.
- Community mobilization agent.
- Advisor for associations development.
- Community activities organiser.
- Association manager.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 721/2011 of May 20th, by which four professional certificates in the professional family of Sociocultural and Community Services, included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates are established, and the professional certificates established as Appendices I and II of Royal Decree 1379/2008 of 1 August (Appendix II, Code: SSCB0109) are included.

Amended by Royal Decree 625/2013 of August 2nd, by which four professional certificates in the family of Sociocultural and Community Services, included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates are established, and the professional certificates established as Appendix IV of Royal Decree 1697/2011 of November 18th, as Appendix II of Royal Decree 721/2011 of May 20th and as Appendix II of Royal Decree 1379/2008 of August 1st, amended by Royal Decree 721/2011 of May 20th are included.







6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
