#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to develop the processes of caring, integration and training related to deaf people and their environment, except for the formal educational environment, as well as in social awareness actions relating to the community of deaf people. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Use Spanish sign language for the job (UC1437\_3).
- Advise and raise awareness among individuals, groups and institutions on the deaf community (UC1477\_3).
- Act, support and assist in the creation and development of the network of grass-roots associations (UC1023 3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Spanish sign language (MF1437\_3).
- Awareness and training regarding the deaf community (MF1447\_3).
- Promotion and support of associations (MF1023 3).
- Practical training at the workplace in monitoring of promotion and participation of the deaf community (MP0495)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Boost sociocultural activities within the associations of deaf people, promoting spaces for integration, entertainment and leisure for them, using Spanish sign language.
- Develop the programming of leisure, training and/or information activities within the associations of deaf
  people on the question of rights and the exercise of citizenship in conditions of equality using Spanish sign
  language.
- Organise and execute awareness-raising dissemination and participation actions aimed at the general population according to the environment, the real situation and the needs of the group belonging to the deaf community.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the sector of services that develop projects for actions with deaf people, specifically in: Organisations representing deaf people with specific programmes for deaf people; Associations of families of deaf people; Care centres for the disabled; Local, provincial and regional agencies; Units or programmes related to disabilities; Centres for job placement and occupational integration; Day centres; Different residential centres; Accommodation centres; Long-term hospitalisation units; Psycho-social rehabilitation centres; Companies offering accessibility services; Public and private entities that have a sporadic rather than constant relationship with deaf people. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Development agent for the deaf community.
- Promotion, care and training agent for deaf people.
- Outreach agent for the deaf community.
- Social mediator for the deaf community.



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#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

#### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

#### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

#### Legal basis

Royal Decree 625/2013 of 2 August, establishing four professional certificates in the family Sociocultural and Community Services, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates, and updating the professional certificates established as Appendix IV of Royal Decree 1697/2011 of 18 November, as Appendix II of Royal Decree 721/2011 of 20 May and as Appendix II of Royal Decree 1379/2008 of 1 August, amended by Royal Decree 721/2011 of 20 May. (Appendix IV, Code: SSCG0112)

#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

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#### **Entry/access requirements:**

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
