#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to organise, manage and supervise the maintenance of structural elements and surface coating of sporting and recreational boats under quality criteria, observing the national and international current norms, using the English language where appropriate and fulfilling labour and environmental risk prevention plans of the company. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units** (UC):

- Organise and supervise the operations of preparation, protection and beautification of sport and recreational vessels surfaces (UC1990 3).
- Organise and supervise the repair of wooden elements of sport and recreational vessels (UC1991\_3).
- Organise and supervise the repair of elements of plastic reinforced with fiber and epoxy resins of sport and recreational vessels (UC1992 3).
- Manage the maintenance of sport and recreational vessels (UC1993\_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the learning outcomes defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Organization and supervision of the preparation, surface protection and beautification of sport and recreational vessels operations (MF1990 3).
- Organization and supervision of repair of wooden elements of sport and recreational vessels (MF1991 3).
- Organization and supervision of repair elements of plastic reinforced with fiber and epoxy resins of sport and recreational vessels (MF1992\_3).
- Maintenance management of sport and recreational vessels (MF1993 3).
- Practical training at the workplace in organization and supervision of the maintenance of structural elements and cladding on the surface of sport and recreational vessels (MP0581).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the location, diagnosis and assessment of damage in wooden elements (structural, interior, etc.), after the supervision of the dismantling or removal of the affected areas in sport and recreational vessels.
- Participate in organizing and supervising the repair of wooden elements of sport and recreational vessels.
- Participate in the organization, monitoring, location and diagnosis of the repair of items of plastic reinforced with fibre and epoxy resins of sport and recreational vessels.
- Participate in the organization and supervision of the operations of preparation, surface protection and beautification of sport and recreational vessels.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.







#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in: shipbuilding (construction of yachts and sport); naval repair and maintenance in shipyards and banks. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Head of paint shop in sport and recreational vessels.
- Head of equipment and/or painters manager in sport and recreational vessels.
- Maintenance foreman of wooden elements of sport and recreational vessels.
- Responsible for carpentry workshop.
- Head of maintenance of elements of plastic reinforced with fiber and epoxy resins of sport and recreational vessels.
- Expert auditor of sport and recreational vessels.
- Master caulk.

This Professional Certificate accredits the minimum training necessary to perform the functions of occupational risks prevention of basic level, according to Appendix IV of Royal Decree 39/1997 of January 17th by which the Regulation Services Prevention is approved.

#### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

## Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

## Legal basis

Royal Decree 992/2013 of December 13th, by which eight professional certificates of the professional family Transport and Vehicle Maintenance, included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established. (Appendix VIII, Code: TMVU0512)







#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

### **Entry/access requirements:**

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
